

RESOLUTION REGARDING CHARGES FOR
CURRENT SERVICES

The Town Board of the Town of Liberty by motion duly made and seconded, adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Liberty authorizes that snow and ice removal be performed as a current service for those Town residents so requesting the service;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the full cost of those current services be charged to the property owner;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said charges shall be due ^{annually} and payable in a lump sum on or before ~~July thirty first~~;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if said charge for current services is not paid on or before _____, said charge shall become a lien on the property against which it is charged on behalf of the Town of Liberty as of the date of such delinquency and said amount shall automatically be extended upon the current or next tax roll as a delinquent tax against the property;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any special charge not paid shall accrue interest from the date of delinquency at the rate of one percent (1%) per month.

This resolution is adopted pursuant to Section 66.60(16), Wisconsin Statutes.
