RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGN

WHEREAS, the Town of Liberty Town Board, in the interest of public health and safety, finds it necessary and appropriate to regulate stop signs within the Town at designated intersections as described in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has the authority to adopt these regulations pursuant to village powers pursuant to Section 60.10, Wis. Stat., as a reasonable exercise of its police power provided thereby, and pursuant to Sections 349.065 and 349.13, Wis. Stat.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin as follows:

STOP SIGN PLACEMENT. A stop sign shall be erected as follows: on Madson Road at the Tee intersection with Nagle Road/Wehausen Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board shall arrange for the erection of signs according to all applicable ordinances, statutes, and Motor Vehicle Code for the purpose of carrying out the terms of this resolution.
