ORDINANCE NO. 2003- 1

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH STOP SIGN ON BOLDT ROAD

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, finds it necessary and appropriate to regulate traffic at the intersection of Boldt Road and Rusch Road in the Town of Liberty in order to preserve and promote public safety, health, and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, pursuant to its authority under Sections 60.10 and 349.065, Wis. Stat., in order to promote public safety, health, and welfare, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. STOP SIGN PLACEMENT. A stop sign shall be placed on Boldt Road at the intersection with Rusch Road for southbound traffic on Boldt Road approaching the intersection with Rusch Road from the north. A stop ahead sign shall be placed on Boldt Road prior to the stop sign.

SECTION 2. SIGNS. The Town Chairperson or his designee is authorized and directed to install official signs necessary to carry out the terms of this ordinance. Such signs shall be in conformity with the Uniform Traffic Sign Manual, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and all other rules and regulations.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after July 14th, 2003.
