ORDINANCE NO. 2003- 2

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT SMOKING ON TOWN PROPERTY

The Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, pursuant to its village powers, in order to provide for the public health, safety, comfort, and general welfare, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION. "Smoking" shall mean to smoke or carry a lighted pipe, cigar, or cigarette or tobacco-related product in any form.

SECTION 2. INTENT AND PURPOSE. Smoking of tobacco-related products is hazardous to one's health and may affect the health of non-smokers when in the presence of smokers and may be a contaminant to certain food products. This ordinance is adopted for the purpose of protecting the public health, safety, comfort, and general welfare of the public in the Town of Liberty.

SECTION 3. SMOKING PROHIBITED. No person shall smoke in or about any building or structure owned by the Town of Liberty, including, but not limited to, the Town Hall and Shop located at 13812 English Lake Road, Valders, Wisconsin 54245.

SECTION 4. SIGNS PROHIBITING SMOKING.

A. Signs prohibiting smoking consistent with this ordinance shall be posted conspicuously throughout all premises subject to this ordinance.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove, deface, or destroy any "No Smoking" sign or to smoke in any place where a "No Smoking" sign is posted.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. The terms of this ordinance are severable. If any provision hereof is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said findings shall not affect the remaining terms of this ordinance, which shall continue to be in full force and effect.
