ORDINANCE No. 020810

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TOWN CLERK

The Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Pursuant to Sec. 60.30(1e)(a), Wis. Stats., the office of the Town Clerk shall be filled by appointment of a person by majority of the members-elect of the Town Board, as defined in Sec. 59.001(2m), Wis. Stats.
2. The term of office for the appointed Town Clerk shall be a term of ____ years. The appointed officer may be re-appointed for additional terms, subject to town board approval. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for cause as defined under s. 17.001, Wis. Stats. And s. 60.31(1e)(f), Wis. Stats. **(not to exceed 3 years)**
3. This ordinance shall not take effect until it is approved in a referendum which is hereby called for by the Town Board to be held on Tuesday, April 6th, 2010. The referendum question shall be:

“Shall the person holding the office of Town Clerk in the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin be appointed by the Town Board?”

4. This salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.
5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
